You will be tasked with assessing the status of certain water meters using a Geographic Information System (GIS) to locate and report water meter data. To accomplish this task you will be using tablets, cameras, GPS, and mapping systems. Describe how these tools might assist you in the process of documenting the meter locations and their status.

AWARDS

One or two recipients may be chosen for the internship program. It is anticipated that recipients will spend 5-10 hours working in the program each week until school is out and then spend additional time until funds are exhausted or the projects are completed. The program is expected to fund 150-200 hours of service. Work is expected to be performed after school and on weekends and will involve working independently outdoors and in a managed professional office environment.
