

***NOTICE TO DESIGNATE GROUNDWATER PRODUCTION UNITS
AND TO METER ALL NON-EXEMPT WELLS BY AUGUST 15, 2017***

The Board of Directors of Mesquite Groundwater Conservation District has extended the deadline for each Well Owner, or the Owner's agent, to designate a parcel of acres of the Owner's Contiguous Groundwater Rights to be assigned to a Well or Well field which shall be the Groundwater Production Unit ("GPU") for such Well or Well field and to install a District approved flow meter at the Well, or at the central collection point on a closed system until **4:00 p.m. on August 15, 2017.**

Any person, or entity, who fails to designate a GPU and/or does not have a District approved flow meter installed on all non-exempt Wells at the Well, or at the central collection point on a closed system, will be in violation of the District's Rules and the District will assess a Class 2 civil penalty for each of the violations. A Class 2 civil penalty for violation of Rules 4.1 and 5.1 shall not be less than \$25, nor more than \$5,000 per violation, and each day of a continuing violation shall be deemed a separate violation.

You are urged to contact the District office to arrange for an appointment to designate your GPUs and to immediately obtain and install District approved flow meters for all non-exempt Wells at the Well, or at the central collection point on a closed system.

The District seeks your assistance in complying with its Rules. However, if you fail to comply, the District will enforce its Rules and seek all remedies that are available to it under its Rules and the Statutes of the State of Texas.
